

Surrender to the Higher Self: A February Pathwork Intensive



The group felt so familiar and intimate as individuals worked on basic needs for connection, attention, recognition, love. The individual processing seemed like part of a collective group sequence that thoroughly baked us all.

But you become "younger" in the sense of enjoying more, being more vibrant, and having more energy. 'Old age' is nothing but a final product of your defenses against life, others, and yourself.
