AN OUTSTANDING YEAR OF LEADERSHIP, GROWTH & TALENT

As the New Year begins I have been reflecting over the highlights of the past year of serving as the Spiritual Leader for the Philadelphia Pathwork Region. Our region changed enormously during this year.

As most of you know by now we have grown from 8 Helpers to 15 active Helpers. This is exciting on three fronts. First, it is exciting because there are so many more Helpers spreading the words of the Guide throughout the Philadelphia, Pittsburgh and New Jersey areas. Helpers are offering more people the teachings that we know have changed our lives. Second, It means that many more activities can be offered in the region at more varied geographical locations. Third, it is exciting because there are new talents available to the

region as these new Helpers take on leadership in a variety of ways and are offering new and creative ideas. We are grateful for this expansion.

Another outstanding event that I have been reflecting on was the International Leadership Conference held at Sevenoaks, VA. In August, Helpers and leaders from all over the world gathered in Lighthouse which is a huge round room on the upper level of a building nestled in the mountains of VA. We sat in chairs around the circumference of this room. There were 80 of us! There were folks from Canada, Mexico, Brazil, France, Belgium, Finland and Australia to name a few. It was touching. It was awesome to experience all of us speaking the same Pathwork language and teaching the same Pathwork concepts. (Though we had to have interpreters to know this!) It was a

profound experience to witness and feel emotionally the commonality and oneness of Pathwork people around the world. While at the Leadershi conference it was a surprise to me that the reputation of the Philadelphia Pathwork Region is that we are a "healthy and thriving community." These were the words we heard over and over. Those of us attending from our region were sought out by other regions and asked for advice and ideas. In fact, upon returning from the conference I was approached by the New York Pathwork Region and asked to come and speak about what it is that we do in this region to "thrive." (The NYPW Region is really struggling right now, which is sad as this was where Eva gave us so many of the lectures.) It took some thought to agree to talk with them on "thriving"

as the Philadelphia region does not actually have people lined up to get in TP classes or crowding into every workshop. So I asked them what it meant to them to be "healthy and thriving." They said it was not about numbers but about aliveness and passion. Ah, that I can speak about for this region – that is true. On Oct. 7, 2012, I traveled to New York City and shared with the people gathered there what I think the reasons are for Philadelphia's success in energetic aliveness and passion. As I was getting ready to write this letter to you it occurred to me that many of you might not be aware of the specific Pathwork techniques we use to keep our region healthy.
